Summary, Conclusions and Recommendations

The committee was pleased with the overall progress being made in the past 6 months at the laboratory. It was particularly pleasing to see scientific results coming from several of the projects. For example, there are interesting new information on nonlinear tides, data which are changing the design for the plans for the SuperNEMO project and data which have impact on the SuperK-Gd project. The committee is also very pleased to learn of the European support received my NEXT which will enable this important project to proceed. The laboratory also hosted an important international school in particle astrophysics. 37 students from 10 countries attended.

The Committee continues to support the efforts of Professor Bettini who has done an outstanding job in managing the Laboratory and overseeing the installation of the experiments and infrastructure.
